



## Supplemental Home School Program 2017-2018 Grades 3-4



The Supplemental Home School Program is a unique learning opportunity for elementary students. Designed to be a co-operative effort between parent and teacher, we will meet Mondays and Wednesdays from 9am-3pm. The class will be taught by Jenny Bumcrot.

### Program Description:

**Math:** We will be using Bob Jones Math for Grades 3 and 4. We will also be using Marcy Cook Math Centers. Marcy Cook is a Master Educator, author, and math specialist. Her centers provide high level thinking encounters, individual skill building, and problem solving. Students will be required to do homework on the days they do not attend class.

**Literature:** We will read a collection of age appropriate books with study guides from Veritas Press or Progeny Press. Book list possibilities:

- *Charlotte's Web*
- *The Courage of Sarah Noble*
- *A New Coat for Anna*
- *Little House in the Big Woods*

**Spelling:** Evan-Moor's *Building Spelling Skills*, correlated to Common Core state standards. Supplemental phonograms will be taught to reinforce spelling skills using *The Writing Road to Reading*.

**Social Studies:** To be determined.

**Writing:** Paragraph writing, poetry, journaling and bookmaking. The goal is to teach students to love to write!

**Grammar:** *Daily Grams*.

**Art:** Art teacher Patty Palmer has written an amazing art curriculum called *Deep Sparkle*. Her lessons are fun, kids love it, and I have enjoyed using this curriculum. Fun, creative, messy art projects every week!

**Drama:** Improvisation and creativity will be explored through a variety of games and teamwork to perform dramatic presentations. Taught by Natalie Trust twice a month.

### Times and Fees:

**Time:** Mondays & Wednesdays, 9:00am – 3:00pm. Classes will begin September 6, 2017

**Tuition:** \$225 per month (9 months)

**Materials Fee:** \$250

**Application Fee:** \$100 (CAT/TerraNova 2 achievement test administered prior to enrollment at no charge.)

### To Apply:

- Registration for new students opens April 3<sup>rd</sup>. All application components must be received to secure your spot.
- Complete all sections of the *Application for Admission*.
- Complete the *Immunization Form*. Your student's vaccination record must be current or exempt. If your student is dually enrolled, please notify our office. You will not need to complete the Immunization form.
